Honey Mxhokloloshe released from Prison

One of Robin's first youth to ever mentor in 2003. Honey who has been a friend of Hilltop for the last 9 years. He recently returned to Hilltop to re-enter our IT technician program. On Honey's third month here in IT he was falsely accused of a crime, when acting as a good Samaritan. He was sentenced to prison for 18 months. Unfortun-

nately, he represented himself without an attorney. On September 26th, he was released early on good behavior after 3 months. Despite a horrific trauma, Honey has returned radiant and eager to be at Hilltop and wants to start training for a marathon with Stephan our German volunteer in the IT Department. After a touching

re-union, Robin took Honey to King Williams Town shopping and together they purchased some new cloths for Honey for his new life, which Honey truly needed and deserved, after such a disturbing and challenging time of surviving the three months in prison, as an innocent man. Honey is 35 yrs old and the future for him looks bright!
