

How to set client to auto login for user<nn> at client-computer<nn>:

1. do at client-computer:
 1. goto root-console by "su -l root" in terminal.
 2. edit /etc/lightdm/lightdm.conf by "mcedit /etc/lightdm/lightdm.conf"
 3. search the line "#autologin-user="
 4. remove the #
 5. add at end the user+number. Shall be like:
6. "autologin-user=user01"
 7. do so at every client-computer, counting up to 49/last client.
 8. save lightdm.conf
 9. after reboot, the login is skipped.
2. Unfortunately, this change get lost at next reset/restore of the client. To make it permanant, create an new image at /media/images. (Refer also to admin-reference of L4A-docu).
3. For that you have to:
 1. boot into rescue (sda2)
 2. and login as root
 3. run backup-process: enter "backup_sys.sh"
 4. then the new image ist written
